

Curriculum Night

Curriculum Night for our *Primary to Grade 6 students* will be held Wednesday, September 4th, from 6:00 pm-6:45 pm. Curriculum Night is a great opportunity to learn about your child's upcoming school year and some of the class routines. Families are invited to meet in the Gym at 6:00 pm for a brief welcome and introduction before visiting classrooms. You will receive an email from your child's classroom teacher September 4th. There will be two classroom sessions scheduled; 6:10-6:25 pm & 6:30-6:45 pm, to allow families to visit multiple classrooms, if needed. For students starting Pre Primary this September, information will be sent out from our Pre Primary teacher about a visit to the class next week. We will also be having an Ice Cream Social Wednesday, September 4th from 6:45-7:30pm. Pre-Primary-Grade 6 students and families are welcome! It will take place outside.

First Day of School Procedures

Students can arrive at school at 8:40 am and will be outside with teacher supervision. There is no supervision prior to this time. Students are asked to play on the playground side and back of the school (behind the white line), not in front of the school. At 8:50 am the bell will ring and students will come inside and go to their classes for a 9:00 am start time. For the first day, all teachers will be outside to meet their students at 8:40 am and enter together at 8:50 am. Your classroom teacher will share more information through their communication and/or at Curriculum Night.
